OMAN OVERVIEW

After extensive exploration of the entire Omani coastline we founded Arabian Fly Sport Fishing to cater for the international fishing market. We offer the chance to fish this beautiful and remote destination in first class comfort with experienced fishing guides.

Oman's coastline is formed of sprawling sandy beaches, secluded rocky bays and sheer jagged cliffs that plunge dramatically into the ocean. With the Gulf of Oman in the north and the Arabian Sea in the south (a region of the north Indian Ocean) Oman's landscape is truly diverse.

Oman's attractions include a largely untouched coastline, rugged mountain ranges, beautiful riverbeds or Wadi's as they are referred to and vast sand dune filled deserts. There are also many towns steeped in rich history, with their forts, palaces and walled cities. It is truly a mystical and untouched destination with the most welcoming local people you could ever wish to meet.



HOW TO GET TO US

Salalah, Oman

Daily flights from Muscat, Abu Dhabi, Dubai and Doha direct in to Salalah International airport. The Juweira Marina is just 20 minutes drive from the airport and offers four star hotel accommodation, multiple beaches, swimming pools, restaurants, bars, coffee shops, dive facilities and much more. A perfect location for both fishing and non fishing parties.

For the non fishing members of the group there are 1/2 and full day tours on offer to all the beautiful sights and attractions in Salalah and the surrounding area.

THE FISHING

Oman's diverse waters give us the unique opportunity to offer a wide variety of fishing.

Inshore and offshore boat based as well as beach fishing is all available in one location. There are no long journeys each day as the drop off and inshore fishing is just a few minutes from the dock, allowing you to maximising your time on the water.

In the morning you can target tailing T.Africanus (permit), Omani Bream, Milkfish, Queenfish, Bluefish, Pompano and multiple Trevally species whilst drifting along the vast cliff faces or exploring the shallow beaches and secluded bays.

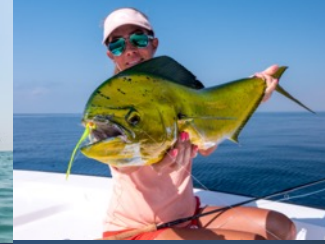
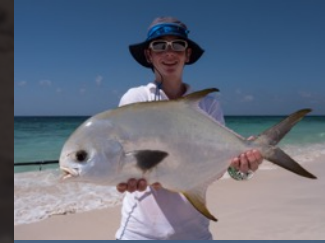
Then spend the afternoon relaxing while you troll for billfish and Dorado along the drop off, or get the blood pumping as you cast to large busting bait balls of Tuna.

Our land based fishing is not for the faint hearted and often require you to hike in to remote beaches. Once there be prepared to run up and down the beach chasing the elusive Indo-Pacific Permit as they tail in the shallows or casting to large spot pompano and Bluefish.

At certain times of the season you might have encounter the odd GT cruising the shoreline in search of a tasty snack.

ACCOMMODATION

Located just 20 minutes from Salalah International airport in the picturesque marina promenade of Hawana. This beautiful 4 star hotel is situated along the white sandy beaches of the Arabian sea with a stunning backdrop of the Jebel Samhan mountains.

The hotel offers luxurious deluxe rooms as well as marina suites, the perfect way to relax after a day out on the water. Amenities include 2 restaurants, a bar, 2 large swimming pools and a state of the art wellness centre.



ITINERARY AND QUOTATION

Day 1

Upon arrival into Salalah International airport, Oman you will be met by a representative from the Juweira boutique hotel and transferred directly to the hotel (approximately 20 minutes by car). You will be staying on a half board basis (breakfast and dinner included) please note check in is at 3pm. Brandon King will meet you after check in to brief you on the following days fishing, set up all your rods and answer any questions that you have.

Day 2-7

Breakfast is served from 7am and Brandon will meet you afterwards at the boat which is located on the floating dock at the back of the hotel, just below the small swimming pool. You will have 6 fully guided days fishing which includes lunch and water/soft drinks on board. Each day can be tailor made to your requests and preferences. Returning to the dock around 4pm, the evenings are at your own leisure with a variety of cuisines being served in the hotel restaurant.

Day 8

Check out is by noon (if your flight is later we will request a late check out but this is not guaranteed). You will then be transferred back to Salalah International airport for your flight home.

- Omani Visa (approx. \$52 for 30 days)
- Fishing equipment (which can be hired upon request)
- Alcohol which is available throughout the marina in the bars and hotels.
- Items of a personal nature
- Gratuities (which are at your own discretion)

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment:

Reservations will be held for 2 weeks and we require a 50% deposit to confirm your booking with final payment no later than 90 days prior to your trip.

Cancelation Policy:

If you wish to cancel your booking more than 90 days prior to your trip the deposit will be forfeited, If you wish to cancel your booking less than 90 days prior to your trip the full invoiced amount shall be forfeited. We will endeavour to move your booking to another date within a 12 month period but this is at our discretion.

Weather and Natural Disasters:

Client safety is of utmost importance to us therefore if the captain deems it unsafe to fish due to weather/natural disasters which are out of our control then every effort will be made to reschedule your missed day on the water. We highly recommend you have travel insurance to cover any of these eventualities as a refund will not be issued in these circumstances.

Indemnity:

All of our clients are required to read, fill out and sign an indemnity form on arrival.

Travel Insurance:

All our clients are required to have FULL travel insurance to cover them for the duration of their time with us. This must include 'from scene of accident MediVac Insurance'.

Equipment Rental:

Any equipment hired through Arabian Fly will be the responsibility of the client for the duration of their trip and any loss or breakages will incur extra costs

Flights:

Arabian Fly can not be held responsible for any changes, cancellations or missed internal or external flights booked by us, a 3rd party or by our clients.

Hotels:

Hotel rates are subject to change and do vary throughout the season. We cannot guarantee hotel prices until your booking has been confirmed and deposit amount received.

FAQ

- Oman is a malaria free zone
- Safety - there are no records of piracy or terrorist attacks/activities in Oman
- Omani Visas should be purchased prior to arrival via <https://evisa.rop.gov.om>
- Alcohol is not permitted on the boat or anywhere outside of the hotels/bars
- The tap water is safe to brush your teeth, but due to the desalination process we suggest you only drink bottled water
- Females are respectfully requested to cover their knees and shoulders when outside of the hotel grounds. There is no need to cover your head unless you plan on visiting a mosque where you will be required to cover your head, and wear clothing that covers your wrists and ankles
- There are shops with basic essentials in each of our locations, however we suggest you arrive with enough sunscreen and toiletries for your stay
- Cell phones work throughout Oman and 4G is available in most areas with WIFI in all of the hotels. There is however NO cell phone signal on most of our permit beaches and in some areas when on the boat
- We do carry a satellite phone for emergencies when fishing at both of our locations
- Hire rods and reels are available on request (10wt -12wts) please let us know in advance if you would like this service and if you are right or left hand wind
- We have a large selection of flies that can be purchased prior to your trip that we will have ready for you on arrival. It is always worth purchasing your flies from the outfit you are visiting as we know what is working at that time of year which saves you wasting money on flies you do not need
- All of our guides have valid captains licences and
- Every member of our team has had first aid training and certification
